

## **Frequently Asked Questions About Shining Stars**

### **How do out of town participants book travel?**

### **What should I bring for my child's costume?**

Shining Stars are given costume pieces which they design throughout the week.

### **What does my child wear each day?**

At registration, your child will be given two Camp Broadway t-shirts to be worn each day. In addition to that, comfortable non-constricting clothes and soft-soled sneakers or dance shoes for class.

### **Does the cost of the camp cover meals?**

Camp Broadway provides lunch, one snack and a bottle of water each day.

### **Will the participants be in the same location every day?**

Camp will be held, each day, at Chelsea Studios. Chelsea Studios is located at 151 W.26<sup>th</sup> Street, New York, NY 10001.

### **What is the new age range of campers?**

Shining Stars is for campers ages 6-9.

### **Will parents be able to watch rehearsals?**

Due to space constraints, parents will not be permitted to watch rehearsals.

### **Are recording devices acceptable to bring to the Family Finale?**

Recording devices are welcome and encouraged.

### **How long will the final performance run?**

The Family Finale typically runs between fifteen minutes to a half an hour and they will perform it twice.

### **Do you have to purchase tickets to the Finale?**

Tickets to the finale are free. You are welcome and encouraged to bring as many people to enjoy the experience as you like.

### **What does my child need to bring the first day of camp?**

A desire to have fun and be creative.

### **When do we see them perform and where?**

The Family Finale will be held at Chelsea Studios.

### **Is there a way to arrange someone, other than myself, to pick up my child at the end of the day?**

If you have authorized someone else, in writing, then we will release your child to that person.

### **Can I add someone to my child's sign-out list over the phone?**

Camp Broadway cannot accept sign-out authorizations over the phone. You can always add to your child's authorization form, or authorize them to self sign-out, by downloading a new form (part of the camp application) and faxing or sending it in.

**Do we have to have the doctor's note and immunization records?**

If you do not have immunization records, or you've declined to have your child immunized, a waiver is acceptable.

**What are the sizes of the groups?**

Each Shining Stars session has a maximum of 25 participants.

**What is the ratio of teacher to camper?**

The Shining Stars ratio is 1:7.
